



Class of 2025 “Memory Wall” Photo Collage

Dear Senior Parents and/or Guardians,

The class of 2025’s Senior All Night Safe & Sober Grad Night Party will be here before we know it! An important and memorable part of Grad Night is the “Memory Wall”, which is a collection of individual photo collages displaying a photo history of the graduating seniors.

To make this possible, we ask each Senior’s family to create a collage. Here’s how:

- Collect either physical or digital photos of your Senior ~ these can be from birth to present, or just high school years. Include pictures from birthdays, vacations, sports, clubs, family events, and friendships. We want the seniors to be proud. Please **DO NOT** include photos that would embarrass your senior.
- Arrange the photos horizontally or vertically. Common sizes are 11” x 14” and 12” x 18”. **PLEASE DO NOT MAKE YOUR POSTER BIGGER THAN 12” x 18”.**
- If you use printed photos to make the collage, make a color copy of your photo collage at a copy center of your choice.
- If you create your collage online, you do not need a copy but will still need to get it printed.
- Put your Senior’s name on the front of the collage.
- Laminate the color copy.
- **Turn in the laminated copy to the Granada office by Friday May 9, 2025.**
The office is open Mon-Fri 8:30-4:00.
- Keep your original photos. Seniors will not bring the collage home. Collages are saved at the school to display at future reunions.

Online companies offering a “photo collage poster” template: CVS Photo, Walgreens, Shutterfly, Walmart, Ritzpix.com. You may also use one you find.

We ask that you make 2 copies of your Senior’s collage ~ one for the school and one for you to keep. The Seniors tend to want to take them home at the end of the night to keep or give to their parent(s). By making 2 copies, our hope is they won’t be tempted to take them home. It is a tradition to use them at future class reunions. We hope you take the time to complete this project and share special memories of your Senior with their classmates.

Please turn in your collage on or before: **Friday, May 9, 2025**
